Required Experience

A minimum of 20 days of experience within the last three years in film and television, short films, commercials, music videos, video projects, etc. Please specify the production company, exact dates, number of days worked, job title/duties, and supervisors. In addition to this, applicants can also include theatre, print work, other freelance work, and any other makeup-related experience.

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Portfolio: Required Skills

A portfolio must be submitted for review by Local 849's Makeup Department. Please submit as a PDF. Your portfolio will be discussed during the Makeup Set Etiquette course and orientation. Photos should be good quality, good lighting, unfiltered, and unedited. Applicants should include this checklist with their application, marking off the skills they have.

Applicant's portfolio must demonstrate ability in the following areas:

- Corrective & Glamour Makeup (two or more skin tones)
- Human Hair Beards: Hand-laid application, grooming, and ventilated pieces.
- Male Facial Hair Grooming & Trimming: Before and after application.
- Makeup for Film & High-Definition Television: Including men's and women's corrective makeup.
- Glamour Makeup for Black and White Film & Photography: At least one example. This may include any period/era style or drag makeup. (two or more skin tones)
- Pros-aide Transfer: Application and colorization.
- Tattoo Cover: Before and after examples for two or more skin tones.
- Out-of-Kit Makeup Effects - Examples must include at least one of each (two or more skin tones over all of the below skills, not two or more skin tones per each skill):
 - Scrapes and scratches.
 - Wound (cut) construction.
 - Bullet hole construction.
 - Burned skin.
 - Stitches.
 - Black (bruised) eye.
 - Fresh and aged blood dressing.
 - Varied dirt applications.
 - Airbrush Skills: Proficiency in 3D painting and/or prosthetic applications beyond corrective makeup. This could include fantasy or character designs.
